

Real Flame[®] Canned Gel Fuel

Instructions for Use

- Shake can well. Remove paper label.
- Contents may be under pressure. Open carefully. Place hand over lid and open away from you. Save lid for later use.
- Do not pour or scoop gel out of the can. Light Real Flame[®] gel fuel only when can is placed in the designated area in unit. Wipe up spills. Use a long match or extended butane lighter to ignite fuel.
- Never move or replace cans while they're burning. Cans get hot. If they are dropped or burning fuel is spilled, it could injure people or set surroundings on fire.
- Do not refill or add any kind of fuel to gel cans.
- Do not obstruct or inhibit the flame by placing anything in or over the can.
- Do not burn more than the maximum number of cans specified in the instructions for the gel fuel product.
- To extinguish flame, wipe off excess gel on lid and replace lid upside down on can with a magnetic lid opener or tongs. Allow cans to cool for 20 minutes before touching them.
- Real Flame[®] gel is formulated specifically for products made by Real Flame[®]. Do not use with any other products.
- Use Real Flame[®] gel fuel within one year of purchase. Always store in a cool, dry place.



- **Gel fuel is flammable. Failure to follow the above instructions and these warnings can result in serious injury, death or property damage.**
- Gel fuel cannisters are single use only. Do not refill cannisters. Risk of serious burn injury or death can occur if fuel is poured into a cannister or fire pot that is still burning or hot.
- Never add fuel to a fire pot or other product designed for use with gel fuel cannisters. Adding fuel to a fire pot could result in flare-ups or flashback resulting in serious burns, death or property damage.
- Fire pots and gel fuel are hot and can burn. Do not attempt to move or touch a lit fire pot or gel fuel cannister. Touching a lit or hot fire pot or cannister can result in burns or spilling of gel fuel resulting in fire.
- Improper use of gel fuel or gel fuel products can result in serious injury or death. Only use gel fuel cannisters in approved products. Failing to do so can result in fire, serious injury, or death.
- Heat rising from lit cannisters can burn or ignite items above. Allow open space of at least three feet above gel fuel cannister. Allowing insufficient space above cannister could result in fire, serious injury, death and property damage.
- Do not store or use near items that can spark or near gasoline or other flammable materials. An open flame or intense heat could ignite fuel or vapors that might leak and travel from these containers, which could start fires or cause the containers to explode.

In case of fire use a CO2 fire extinguisher or baking soda to extinguish flames



Real Flame[®] Gel Fuel contains isopropyl alcohol.

Avoid contact with eyes, mucous membranes or prolonged contact with skin.

May irritate eyes. If gel gets in eyes, flush with water for 15 minutes; get medical attention. If ingested, do not induce vomiting; call a poison control center or a doctor.
